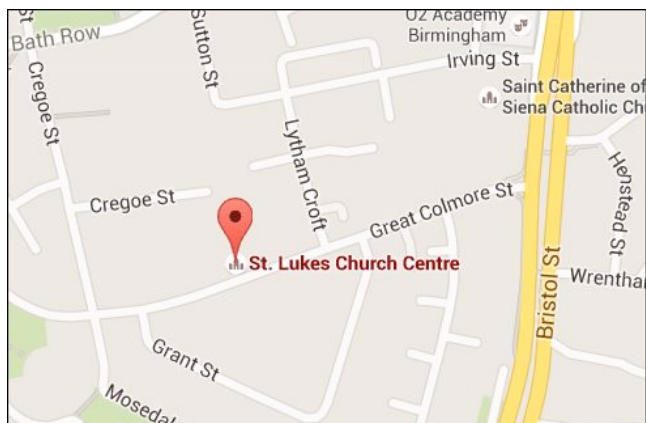

The Speakers

John Hemming

Educated at King Edwards School Birmingham gaining a scholarship to Magdalen College, Oxford reading Natural Sciences. Gained a MA (Oxon) specialising in Atomic, Nuclear and Theoretical Physics.

City Councillor for Birmingham. Former Leader and Deputy Leader of Birmingham City Council. Group Chair Birmingham Liberal Democratic Group. John works for and with McKenzie Friend Support in Family Legal proceedings, giving quiet advice and assisting with documents without payment. Is experienced in preparing court applications and representations.

Dr. Kevin Felstead

In 2001 Kevin Felstead was awarded a doctorate from Keele University where he taught courses on the history of crime, policing and punishment in England and Wales since 1800. He was subsequently employed by Manchester City Council working in the field of community safety, neighbourhood crime and justice. Kevin is currently employed as Director of Communications for the British False Memory Society. Kevin has been interviewed for multiple press releases about false-memory type allegations. He has given talks at Goldsmiths, Glasgow Caledonian, Portsmouth and Warwick Universities. He recently gave a talk at a TEDx conference at Newcastle University. Kevin has been featured on BBC London News and contributed recently to a broadcast by the BBC World Service - 'The Why Factor - Hypnosis: Why Would Anyone Allow a Stranger to Access Their Mind ?' He is the author of Justice for Carol: The Creation of a Satanic Myth in the United Kingdom. His family have set legal precedent by being given rare permission from the Solicitor General (twice) to apply to the High Court (Royal Courts of Justice) to quash an inquest into his sister's death.
